
# The Latest Developments in Spent Fuel Management and Transportation

and back-end programs around the globe, including short- and long-term storage plans, developments related to national or regional permanent disposal facilities, reprocessing, and mixedoxide fuel.




### Dry Storage in the U.S.

The StoreFUEL and Decommissioning Report was created to assist utility fuel managers, cask designers, fabricators, and other related companies in tracking the current on the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's (NRC) certification process for spent fuel cask technology. StoreFUEL, published the first week of every month, also includes U.S. cask vendor licensing activities, a summary and detailed tables of all active and

planned dry storage programs in the U.S., and updates on shutdown reactors and other decommissioning activities in the U.S.

A one-year subscription to *StoreFUEL* starts at US\$2,250 for the base subscription level.
